#### Assurance of Pardon -

We hear a reminder from Scripture that Jesus Christ has addressed the reality of sin through His life, death, resurrection and ascension.

This is an ancient greeting of brothers and sisters in Christ. After we have reflected and entered into God's presence, we greet one another with the peace of Christ as common forgiven sinners. As we are forgiven, so we forgive. As you are able, greet those around you with a kind word.

#### Lord's Supper -

As Christ demonstrated in the Lord's Supper, we enter into communion with Him when we share the bread and the cup of communion. We believe the Holy Spirit uses this sacrament to unite us to Jesus in a special way.
